Information and Booking Form

Gridwork, course jumping and XC

9th–11th August 2019



Location: Poplar Park, Hollesley, Woodbridge IP12 3NA

General information

This camp is suitable for all levels of rider.

Camp is residential, beginning on Friday 9th August (arrival from 12pm) and finishing on Sunday 11th August at approximately 5pm.

Teaching takes place in small groups of appropriate abilities. There is an option for a private lesson on Friday afternoon, for an additional £20.

Deposit of £50 at time of booking to secure place; final cost (not including optional extras) £220.

What's included

- Overnight stabling Friday and Saturday, including straw bedding (or left empty if you want to bring your own shavings)
- Use of all facilities (Friday afternoon, Saturday and Sunday)
- Lessons on Saturday and Sunday
- Unlimited hacking

Hay or haylage can be purchased on-site by the net (£1.00 per net of hay, £1.50 per net of haylage).

Please bring your own feed, water buckets and mucking out equipment although there are some wheelbarrows available for use.

Proposed Schedule

Times for lessons will be allocated in advance.

Friday 12pm onwards: Arrivals. Private lessons to those who have pre-booked this option

Friday Evening: BYO BBQ

Saturday AM: Gridwork lessons (small groups of appropriate abilities)

Saturday PM: Coached clear-round SJ course jumping (individual). Optional hacking

Saturday Evening: Camp meal at local pub (walking distance)

Sunday: Cross Country lessons (small groups of appropriate abilities). Optional hacking

Accommodation

B&B is available on-site at approximately £30–£50 per person per night (dependent on room/occupancy). This includes a 'help yourself' breakfast. Please indicate on the form if you would like B&B and we will confirm the price before booking.

Campers are welcome to stay in their own lorries, trailers, or tents. There is limited hook-up available. Please state on the form if you require hook-up; it will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

Meals

Campers are to cater their own food for the weekend, with the exception of breakfast for B&B residents. We have use of a common room with kettle, microwave, sink and fridge.

Friday evening is BBQ night. We will provide the BBQ itself but please bring any food you would like to cook.

Saturday evening is pub night or fish and chips. If you'd like to come along please indicate on the form and pre-order menus will be sent to you when they become available.

Rules

- All attending horses must be passported and vaccinated.
- Hats must be worn at all times while riding. Back protectors are recommended for showjumping and compulsory for cross country.
- When riding outside of lessons you must ride in pairs (for safety). Maps are available for extensive hacking.
- Please only bring dogs if absolutely necessary. While on-site, dogs must be kept on a lead at all times (no exceptions). This is for the safety of your own dog, resident dogs, and horses and riders and is non-negotiable. There are plenty of footpaths within walking distance where dogs can be exercised off-lead if desired.
- Bookings can only be taken with deposit of £50 to secure place. Final cost (not including optional extras) of £220 (to be paid by 30th June 2019).
- Riders under 18 are welcome but those under 16 must be accompanied by a chaperone.

Refunds

A refund of the £50 deposit is given on production of a vet's or doctor's certificate stating that the horse or you will not be fit for work on the dates of the camp. No deposit refunds will be given for change of mind or circumstances.

The balance (less the deposit) will be refunded if we are able to fill your place and notice is given before 30th June. There will be no refunds, regardless of veterinary or doctor's notes, for cancellations after this date.
