## **ABOUT THIS EVENT:**

- Long-reining competitions are open to members and non-members of Long-reiningUK.
- Long-reiningUK members can gain points at this competition for annual awards.
- Beginners to long-reining are very welcome - please ask if you need any assistance.
- All classes have a drawn order - please be ready to compete on time. The drawn order is available from our website or Facebook page, up to 4 days before the competition.
- Competitions may be split (horses/ponies) depending on entries. Multiple turnouts (pairs/tandems/teams) permitted.
- Other equestrian competitions are running at the venue on the day - therefore we will provide a small warm up area in the indoor arena. The number of competitors using this area may be restricted for safety reasons.
- Prizes 1-6th. Special prize for the best performed Traditional Cob and the best performed Young handler (17 years and under).

THERE WILL BE A LUNCH BREAK FOR THE JUDGES & PRESENTATION OF AWARDS FOR THE MORNING COMPETITIONS AT 12.30PM - 1.00PM (APPROX.).

## **THE IMPORTANT STUFF, PLEASE READ:**

1. It is the responsibility of all officials and competitors to ensure they have knowledge of the rules and comply with the rules. When you enter an event, you accept the rules and agree to abide by them. Please READ our handbook, available from our website [www.long-reininguk.org.uk](http://www.long-reininguk.org.uk).
2. Competitors, handlers and owners must have third-party public liability insurance which covers them for attending and taking part in this event. This can be in the form of a membership card for the BHS (Gold), or equestrian club that provides such insurance or a personal insurance policy covering equestrian activities.
3. Parents, Guardians and Carers are responsible for ensuring young and vulnerable people are kept safe at events. Young children must not be left unaccompanied whilst at an event (e.g. left in a horsebox alone).
4. Cruelty to or abuse of any animal (including dogs) by any person at an event is forbidden. Anyone found abusing an animal will be disqualified from the event.
5. Equines must be 3 years of age or over to compete in long-reining competitions. Equines aged 3 yrs must not be ridden at the event, under penalty of disqualification.
6. Handlers and grooms must wear securely fastened protective headgear.
7. Depending on the number of entrants, a turnout may be competed by up to two handles in a competition.
8. Refunds will not be given past the closing date unless a medical or veterinary certificate is provided.
9. Long-reiningUK reserves the right to cancel a class or merge classes depending on entries.

### **Photography at the event**

Any commercial photographer wishing to cover the event is to apply before the date of the event to the competition secretary for permission.

## **AGILITY**

A long-reining competition that requires the handler to demonstrate their reinmanship skills and the obedience and training of the horse when working the through a series of obstacles such as walking over a rubber mat or walking along a wiggly path.

### **Class 1: Agility - Introductory level**

## **LONG-REINING DRESSAGE**

Callers permitted.

### **Class 2 - Club Test (walk only).**

Competitors in this class are not eligible to compete in Class 3. Open to handler/horse combinations who have not previously won a long-reining dressage competition.

## **REINMANSHIP**

A simplified dressage test where movements are performed at markers or between markers placed about the arena. Like Dressage, scores are awarded for each movement with the judge looking for the horse to be obedient, straight, supple and rhythmical. The Handler needs to demonstrate a good workmanlike ability to 'drive' the horse about the arena, confident in rein handling, and deliver an accurate test.

## **CONES&OBSTACLE**

A fun long-reining competition to test the skills of the Handler around a course of cones and one obstacle. The competitor should aim to finish the course as close as possible to the optimum time, with 1 penalty incurred for every second started either side of the optimum time. 3 penalties for a dislodged ball. No timing device, including wrist watches, are to be worn by the competitor. Both horse and handler must pass through the cones obstacles and obstacle gates.

### **Class 7 - Cones&Obstacle - Introductory level**

Cones width set at 1.30m. Obstacles gates set at 2m. Speed 90 metres/per minute.

### **Class 8 - Cones SCURRY - Introductory level**

Cones width set at 1.30m. Complete the course as fast as you can!
