Special rosette for highest place Piebald or skewbald.
- Class 3** **In Hand Novice**, Open to any age, colour or type.
Combination not to have won 2 x 1st at any show up to the entries closing date.
- Class 4** **Colour and markings**, Any age or type . Piebald and Skewbald only.
Special rosette for Best minimal marked.
- Class 5** **4 Year old and over Plaited / Hogged**, Piebald and Skewbald only.
- Class 6** **4 year old and over Traditional / Native**, Piebald and Skewbald only.
Special rosette for Best Miniature.
- Class 7** **4 Year old and over**. Open to any colour or type. Kindly sponsored by suffolk ear care
- Class 8** **Sports Horse or Pony Type**, Open to any age or colour.
- Class 9** **Driving Type**, Open to any age or colour.
- Class 10** **Junior Handler under 16 years**, Open to any age, colour or type.
- Class 11** **Open Handler**, Open to any age, colour or type. To be judged on handlers ability Only. *Special rosette for Best Veteran Handler over 50 years old.*

To follow inhand classes. Not to start before 12.30pm

- Class 13** **Best Turned out**, 4 years old & over. Open to any colour or type.
Prize sponsored by Tack and Turnout.
- Class 14** **Walk and Trot** , 4 years old & over. Combination not to have won 2 x 1st placing previously, Open to any colour or type. No cantering required. Lead rein permitted.
- Class 15** **Junior Ridden**, 4 years old & over. Open to any colour, type or height. Rider 16 years and under and suitably mounted. *Special for Best Lead rein.*
- Class 16** **Novice Horse and Pony** , 4 years old & over. Combination not to have won 2 x 1st placing previously, Open to any colour or type.
- Class 17** **Ridden Plaited / Hogged**. 4years old & over. Piebald and Skewbald only. Any height.
- Class 18** **Ridden Traditional/Native**. 4 years old & over. Piebald and Skewbald only. Any height.
- Class 19** **Ridden Small**, 4 years old & over.14hh and under. Open to any colour or type.
- Class 20** **Ridden Large**, 4 years old & over. Exceeding 14hh. Open to any colour or type.
- Class 21** **Family Horse / Pony**, 4 years old & over. May include a small jump or an obstacle, Any colour or type.
- Class 22** **Sports Horse or Pony Type**. 4 years old & over. Any colour.
- Class 23** **Equitation Riders**, 4 years old & over. To be judged on riding ability only.
- Class 24** **Home Produced**. Please see rules. Open to any colour or type.
Special rosette for Best Piebald or Skewbald.

Break for dressing

- Class 25** **Concours D'Elegance**, 4 years old & over. Open to any colour or type. - Kindly sponsored by Suffolk Pony parties

Rising Star Ridden Championship - Kindly sponsored by Ella Souster Show team

Competition and Safety Rules

Fees for pre-entries must be received by the Secretary as outlined in this schedule with received entry forms. Entries received after that date and on the day will be at an additional fee; also outlined within this schedule. Entry fees are not returnable. If, however, the East Anglian Coloured Society refuse an entry, cancel a class or classes or the Show, entry fees may be refunded at the discretion of the Society Committee.

The East Anglian Coloured Society may refuse an entry or cancel any entry already accepted without giving any reason for doing so and reserves the right to refuse entries from any person who is under exclusion or suspension by any breed, livestock or show organisation. Any fees refunded shall be accepted by the exhibitor or intending exhibitor in full satisfaction of all claims against the Society.

The judge's decision is final. In all cases of dispute a protest in writing, accompanied by a deposit of £20, shall be delivered to the Secretary before the close of the Show, otherwise the protest cannot be entertained. The Secretary shall immediately give notice of the protest to the Chairman of the Show and the Stewards concerned, who shall if possible decide the case before the conclusion of the Show. Otherwise it will be referred to the Society Committee. In either case, the decision shall be final. The deposit of £20 shall be forfeited to the Society if the dispute is upheld in favour of the claimant. When a protest is considered, all parties to the dispute shall be notified.

The East Anglian Coloured Society shall not be liable for any claim in respect of injury, loss, damage or accident to any person, horse or property howsoever caused in connection with, or arising out of this show. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the East Anglian Coloured Society, or any person acting their behalf against any legal action arising from such an incident.

The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present. However for the show to be successful and free from incident everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring. They must therefore obey by the written and verbal instructions of the society organisers and volunteers, and all venue staff.

Competitors and show attendees must abide by the venue rules at all times. **Including Venues current rules regarding Equine influenza vaccines.**

In the interest of safety, when mounted riders must wear protective headgear at all times.

There will be no trotting or cantering in public areas, only in designated horse areas.

Emergency services must be able to access all areas of the show ground, therefore please take this into consideration throughout the show.

All horses and ponies must have 3rd party and public liability insurance.

All horses and ponies must be 4 years old or over to be eligible to compete in ridden classes unless otherwise stated.

All stallions shall only be handled by individuals over the age of 14 and over on the day of the show.

HOME PRODUCED CLASSES – These classes are open to horses and ponies that have been stabled

at home (without any paid assistance) or kept at livery on a DIY basis since 1st January 2018. Horses /ponies must not have been shown or trained by a professional Producer or kept at full livery at any time

during this period (except for service in the case of Brood Mares). To be owned/kept, produced,

ridden/handled by a person who does not derive their main income from working with horses/ponies. It

is anticipated that exhibitors will enter in the true spirit of this competition.
